Joe Fleming indicated that the document will be posted on the DVCA website.

Girls Cricket	 Josephine addressed the Girl's Cricket flyer, together with the FAQ's and encouraged clubs to progress the Girl's Cricket initiative within their clubs Josephine indicated that Shania and herself would be available to support the clubs in this endeavour even if it meant merging teams "Come and Try" days for girls are scheduled to be conducted in the September school holidays. These will also be supported by Cricket Victoria.
